for his swift actions on 5th March 2023 when, as skipper of yacht Escape Cat, he alerted Port Control of the Port of Table Bay and nearby vessels of a Man Overboard (MOB) from the Harbour Wall in the Victoria & Albert harbour basin and then immediately went to the assistance of the man in the water.

NSRI Table Bay, while on exercise just outside the harbour, were alerted by Port Control to respond and on arrival found that the casualty had already been rescued aboard the yacht Escape Cat, brought to the quay side and handed into the care of paramedics, where he was pronounced stable and transported to hospital for further treatment.

Lucky's calmness and presence of mind to immediately raise an MOB alert and get the attention of all boaters in the immediate vicinity to assist without delay, pinpointing the casualty's position thus speeding the subsequent rescue, undoubtedly saved his life. As fellow South Africans we are proud to be able to recognise and honour this achievement.
