From 11 to the 13 April 2022, days of heavy rain across KwaZulu-Natal led to deadly floods. Particularly hard-hit were areas in and around Durban. At least 435 people died across the province, with an unknown number of people still missing as of 13 April 2022. Several thousand homes were damaged or destroyed. Critical infrastructure, including major roads, transportation, communication and electrical systems, were impacted by the flooding, and this damage greatly hampered rescue, recovery and relief efforts.

Jazmynn Eksteen is being recognised for her courage and determination on 11 April 2022 when she and members of her NSRI Station, along with the national and local emergency services, rendered aid and assistance in multiple flood-related incidents. These incidents occurred along the KwaZulu-Natal coastline and inland due to heavy rainfall, resulting in devastating floods in Durban and surrounding areas.

In particular, we acknowledge Jazmynn's part in assisting Tyron Brennan's team and her own actions in the rescuing of a family of 3 trapped in their beds in their collapsed house in Westville as a result of surging flooding and landslides. After extracting the son from his room using a portable jaws-of-life to lift a collapsed exterior wall, they tackled the extraction of the parents, using a sledge hammer for 2 hours to break through the stricken house to extract the father, who with 2 broken feet managed to crawl from his crushed room to safety. The mother had unfortunately passed away from her injuries and her body was extracted and handed into forensic care.

Jazmynn Eksteen's personal bravery that day, going to the aid of persons in trouble in known dangerous conditions, without concern for her own safety, was in the very finest traditions of the National Sea Rescue Institute, which we are pleased to recognise with this Gallantry Award Bronze.
