In November 2017 Sea Rescue launched an emergency floatation campaign using brightly coloured Pink Rescue Buoys. The idea behind the project is to get emergency floatation to someone who is in danger of drowning as fast as possible while calling for professional help. Each Rescue sign has a location number so that bystanders can tell Sea Rescue volunteers exactly where they are; and the floatation buoys are bright pink so that they can be easily spotted on the water by responding resources and are unique to Sea Rescue.

This project was set up by the National Sea Rescue Institute and is made possible by corporate and public donations and makes up part of an extensive National Drowning Prevention Campaign, with the cooperation of City Councils, Municipalities, Emergency Services and communities.
